Ash Wednesday, February 14th, we begin the season of Lent. The Mass Times are as follows: 10 a.m. at Strasburg; 7 p.m. at Hague (with Fr. Leonard); and 7 p.m. at St. Michael's, Rural Linton. Also, note the Mass Times during Lent for the weekdays. Strasburg will go to 4 p.m. Masses Tuesday through Thursday with Stations of the Cross on Wednesdays at 3:30 p.m. St. Michael's Rural Linton will have Stations of the Cross on Wednesday Evenings at 7 p.m. and Mass at 7:30 p.m. Hague will have Stations of the Cross on Friday Evenings at 6 p.m. and Mass at 6:30 p.m.

Lenten Regulations

Abstinence: Catholics 14 and older must not eat meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and on all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: Catholics aged 18 to 59 years are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these days, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals may be taken, if needed, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

Sacrament of Penance: Catholics older than about 2nd grade are obliged to confess their sins at least once a year. Lent is a fitting time to fulfill this requirement.

Other Lenten Observances: Each weekday of Lent is also a day of penance. Some recommendations include attending daily Mass, increased prayer, study, self-imposed fasting or abstinence, works of charity, giving to the poor, and participation in traditional Lenten devotions such as the Stations of the Cross, the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, etc.

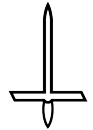
